TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Deadline for application is **June 15, 2010**.
2. Up to three photos/images must be submitted **with** the application. They can be sent electronically to otis-cc@hotmail.com or by snail mail to the address on application. By sending your images, you are granting us permission to use them for advertising purposes. Photos will become the property of the Otis Cultural Council. We cannot accept slides.
3. The entry fee of \$15 is *refundable* until **July 17, 2010**.
4. It is recommended that each vendor provide his or her own 6-or 8-foot tables. There are a very limited number of tables available provided by OCC, and a vendor must request a table on the application, if you need one.
5. The layout of the Otis Arts Festival includes temporary partitions for hanging of art work that will be in place before artists arrive on Friday. Since limited hanging space is available, we ask that you describe the space needed on your application. **NO** artwork may be hung on school walls. Artists will have an assigned, numbered space and will be guided to it by OCC staff upon arrival to assist with setup.
6. **Artists are responsible for setup of their work on Friday, July 23 between 2 p.m. and 6 p.m. or on Saturday, July 24, from 7:45 a.m. and be completed by 9 a.m.**
7. We recommend arriving on Friday should you foresee a complex setup or if you have reserved hanging space.
8. **All vendors are required to attend to their booth all day, and displays are not to be broken down before 3 p.m.** Volunteers will be available to relieve artists for short periods for restroom or lunch breaks.
9. Please bring lunch or snacks. Coffee and cake will be available.
10. The OCC reserves the right to refuse a vendor application if the Council determines that it is inappropriate for this event.
11. The Farmington River Elementary School is secured by an alarm system. The Town of Otis, Farmington River Elementary School and/or any member of the Otis Cultural Council shall not be held liable or be responsible for damages, injury or theft to any artwork or craft installed at the school for this event.
