

EMERGENCY ITEMS FOR POWER OUTAGES

- 1. Generator (gas or propane), extension cords for generator**
- 2. Containers filled with propane/gas for generator or for your automobile (if gas pumps not working in town)**
- 3. Five gallons (or more) of water for manual use (flushing, etc.)**
- 4. Bathtubs filled with water (before storm arrives)**
- 5. Sealed bottles of drinking water (plenty)**
- 6. Battery-operated lantern (fluorescent bulbs last longer)**
- 7. Battery-operated portable radio**
- 8. *Or* hand-cranked portable radio (if no battery for portable)**
- 9. Extra batteries for radio and lantern**
- 10. Gas grill for cooking or boiling water to be used outdoors**
- 11. Candles, matches, fire starter device**
- 12. Chainsaw to cut limbs blocking driveway or doorway**
- 13. Gas for chainsaw**
- 14. Air mattress (for in front of fireplace) at night**
- 15. Canned food (tuna, salmon, etc.) and boxed cereals and snacks (power bars, granola bars), and canned juices**
- 16. Manual can opener**
- 17. If pets, extra pet food**
- 18. Cooler with “freezies” for storage of dairy and milk items**
- 19. Baby wipes (hand-washing, other needs)**
- 20. Cell phone, Princess phone to plug in to phone line**
